Each team will give out one trophy to a player on their team who demonstrates outstanding sportsmanship during the event. It can be a team vote or the coach can make this selection.

**HELP THE REFS!!** In the spirit of this "Friendship and Good Sportsmanship" event, instead of spending over \$2000 for referees, we decided use High School students for referees. Next season, Tribal was re-named this event from Tournament to "Jamboree" to reflect this spirit. *Please remember that this event is to provide young kids the opportunity to be part of a tournament format event which commemorates a wonderful kid who represented the best aspects of youth sports.* If you go with the flow, the players will. Relax about the score and just have FUN, and know that by the time you leave the parking lot today, no-one will remember who won and who lost.

**Participant T-shirts:**

**Food:**

Amesbury Sports Park has a lounge that sells food and beverages. There are also a number of fast food restaurants nearby. **ASP is prepared and staffed for 700+ attendees.**

### **Game Schedule & Field locator**

**Running time each game will be 30 minutes.** All games will start with a central horn blast and end in the same fashion. There are approximately 6 minutes between games.

### **Modified Boys Rules:**

We will use all the same rules as MBYLL, just a smaller version (2 defense, 2 middies, 2 attacks, and a Goalie), with the following modifications:

- We are stressing team work so we are going to have the **boys adapt a “pass rule” before they can shoot.** The U-9 boys must make 2 passes a pass *does not need to be caught to count as long as possession is maintained.* On a change of possession the team with the ball must make the required number of passes before they can shoot. (Coaches should count the passes, and let the kids know when they can take a shot). **The “pass rule” is not in effect on the penalty fast break.**
- Penalties: no time served, but the ball is rewarded at mid field and a fast break occurs. Bring the four midfielders to the center, give the ball 5 yards in front of the mid-stripe, and have other 3 midfielders on the mid-stripe blow the whistle and team with ball has a fast break opportunity. Defensive team will have 2 defenseman, goalie and the offense will have the two attack. As soon as the whistle blows everyone can move.

### **Girls Rules:**

- The format is 7v7 – small field play with 30 minute running time. Basically, very similar to what the girls are already accustomed to with MBGYLL.
- 3 pass rule, no raking, no checking, shooting space, etc...Play will begin with a draw at the beginning. Play will resume after a goal with a clear.
- If the team that was scored on is down by margin of 5 or more goals, possession will be given just across mid-field in the offensive zone.
- Off sides – at least two field players must be on one half of the field at all times
